Exhaust outlets shall be located not less than 10 feet (3048 mm) horizontally from parts of the same or contiguous buildings, adjacent buildings, adjacent property lines and air intake openings into any building and shall be located not less than 10 feet (3048 mm) above the adjoining grade level.

Exception

Exhaust outlets shall terminate not less than 5 feet (1524 mm) from parts of the same or contiguous building, an adjacent building, adjacent property line and air intake openings into a building where air from the exhaust outlet discharges away from such locations.

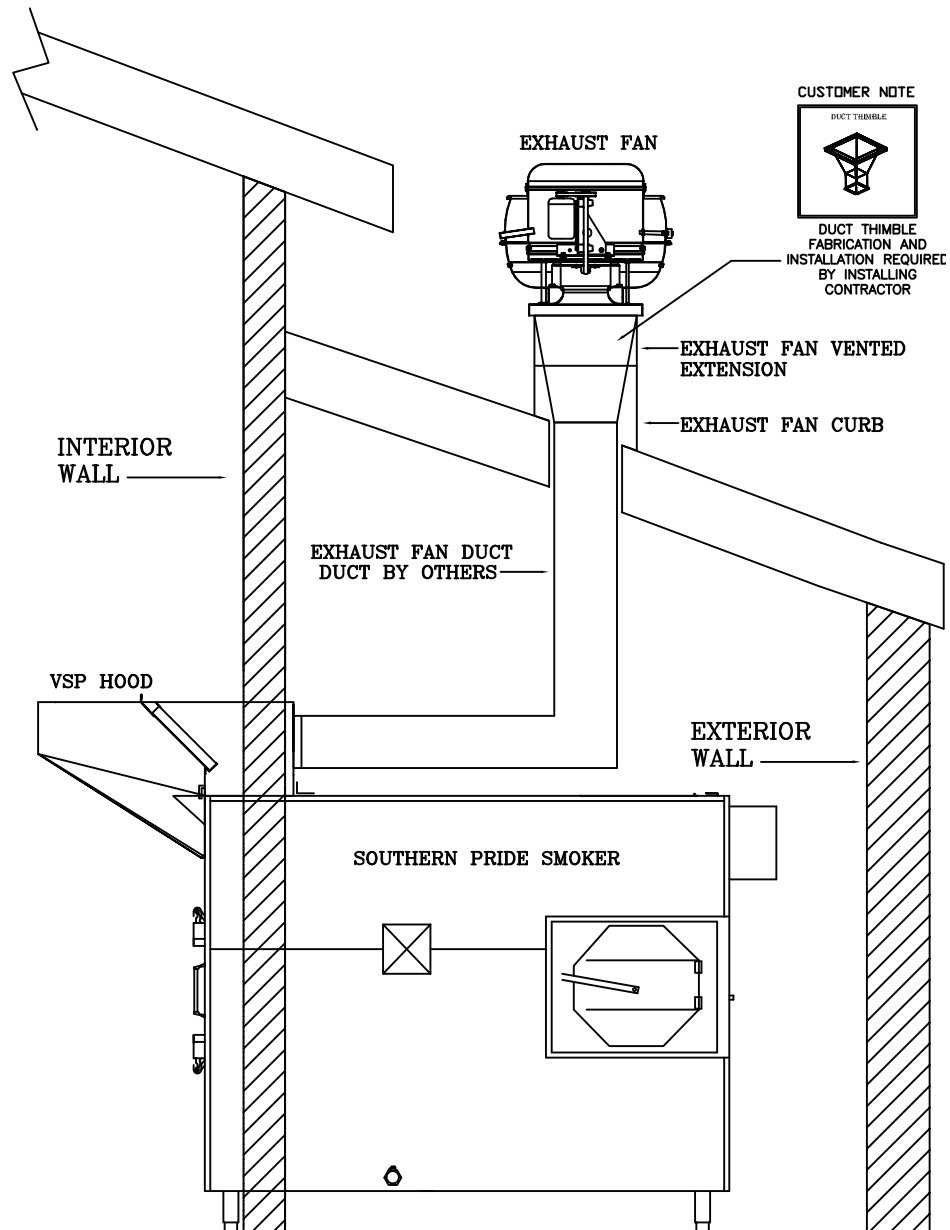

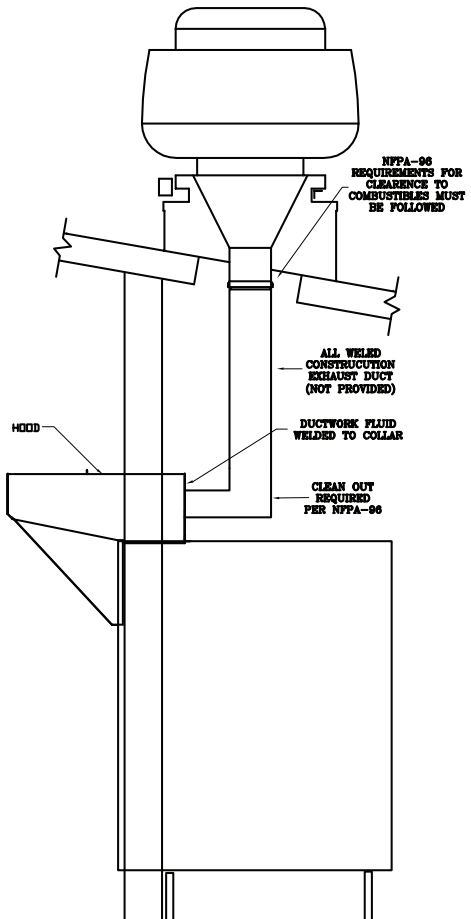
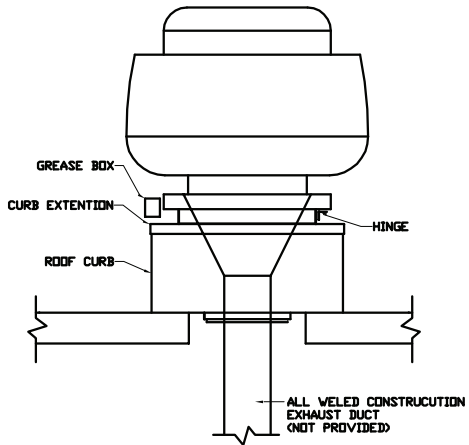
Avtec VSP's sit directly on the Southern Pride Smokers.

1. Check all local codes prior to installation. Special requirements may be necessary depending upon building material construction.
2. Move crated hood to location of installation and very carefully uncrate hood.
3. Raise hood up and sit on the Southern Pride Smoker.
4. Line up hood so it is pushed all the way back so the front tabs of the hood will be secured to smoker oven. (See Figures 1 & 2)
5. Install with self-tapping stainless steel sheet metal screws.
6. Install grease filters into front of hood by sliding them into the filter channel built into the hood.

THE DRAIN CONNECTION IS DESIGNED TO FACILITATE CLEANING AND MUST BE DIRECTED TO FRONT FLUE ON SMOKER SO CONDENSATION DRAINS INTO FLUE.

Exhaust Fan & Duct: When 2-speed exhaust fan is installed correctly, it will operate at a low CFM when oven doors are closed, and a high CFM when doors are open.

1. Check all local codes prior to installation.
2. All exhaust fans are supplied with a minimum 18" high metal curb, hinge kit, and grease box.
3. The exhaust fan curb should be installed directly above the hood if possible. Always maintain the shortest duct run possible.
4. Cut hole and seal exhaust fan curb to roof.
5. Place exhaust fan on curb.
6. Install hinges on exhaust fan cap and metal curb. Remember to leave ample room for fan to tilt back. Fan will remain in tilted back position.
7. Install grease collection box on side of fan that has grease tube discharge.
8. The exhaust duct must be constructed of 16 gauge carbon steel or 18 gauge stainless steel. All seams must be fluid welded.
9. A duct transition should be provided below exhaust fan inlet.
10. The exhaust duct must be fluid welded to hood collar.
11. Make all necessary electrical connections and check fan for proper rotation.
NOTE: Fan will exhaust air running in wrong direction. Refer to page 11.



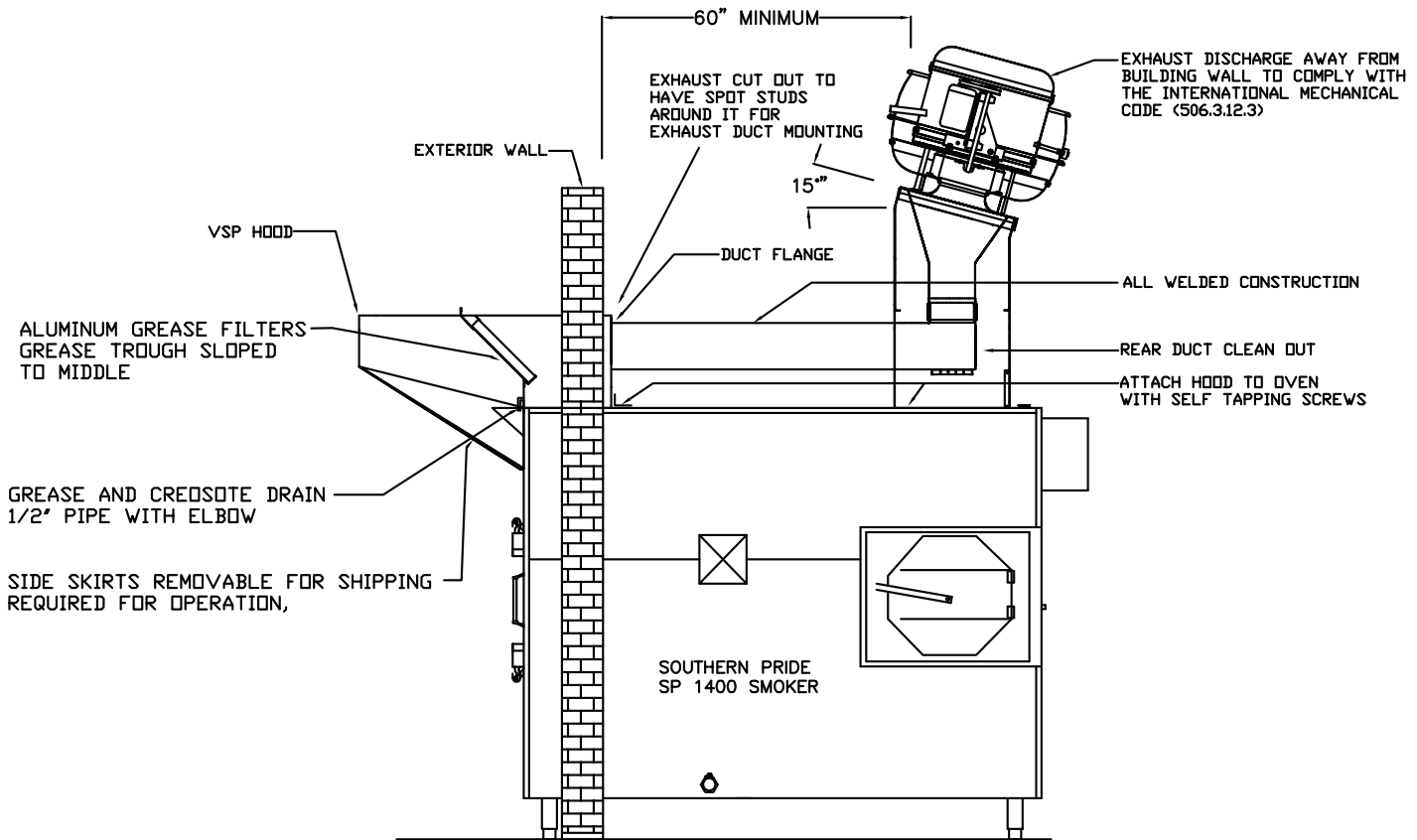
Installation Instructions

International Mechanical Code

506.3.12.3 Termination Location Exception:

Exhaust outlets shall terminate not less than 5 feet (1524 mm) from parts of the same or contiguous building, an adjacent building, adjacent property line and air intake openings into a building where air from the exhaust outlet discharges away from such locations.

1. Check all codes prior to installation.
2. The exhaust fan curb should be installed directly on top of smoker. Connect the exhaust duct to the hood collar. Secure duct with supplied nuts and bolts. (See Figure below)
3. Secure exhaust fan curb assembly to the top of the smoker. Drive screws through flange of curb assembly in to edge of smoker. ****Only along the back edge of the smoker.**** Two screws minimum. Holes may have to be predrilled through flange. (See Figure below)
4. Install hinge kit on curb assembly and exhaust fan. (Provided by fan manufacturer).
5. Install grease collection box on side of fan that has grease tube discharge.
6. Make all necessary electrical connections and check fan for proper rotation.
NOTE: Fan will exhaust air running in wrong direction. Refer to page 11.

NOTICE: It is suggested that a 120V outlet on a 20 AMP breaker be supplied for oven and hood system.

When 2-speed exhaust fan is installed correctly, it will operate at a low CFM when oven doors are closed and a high CFM when doors are open.

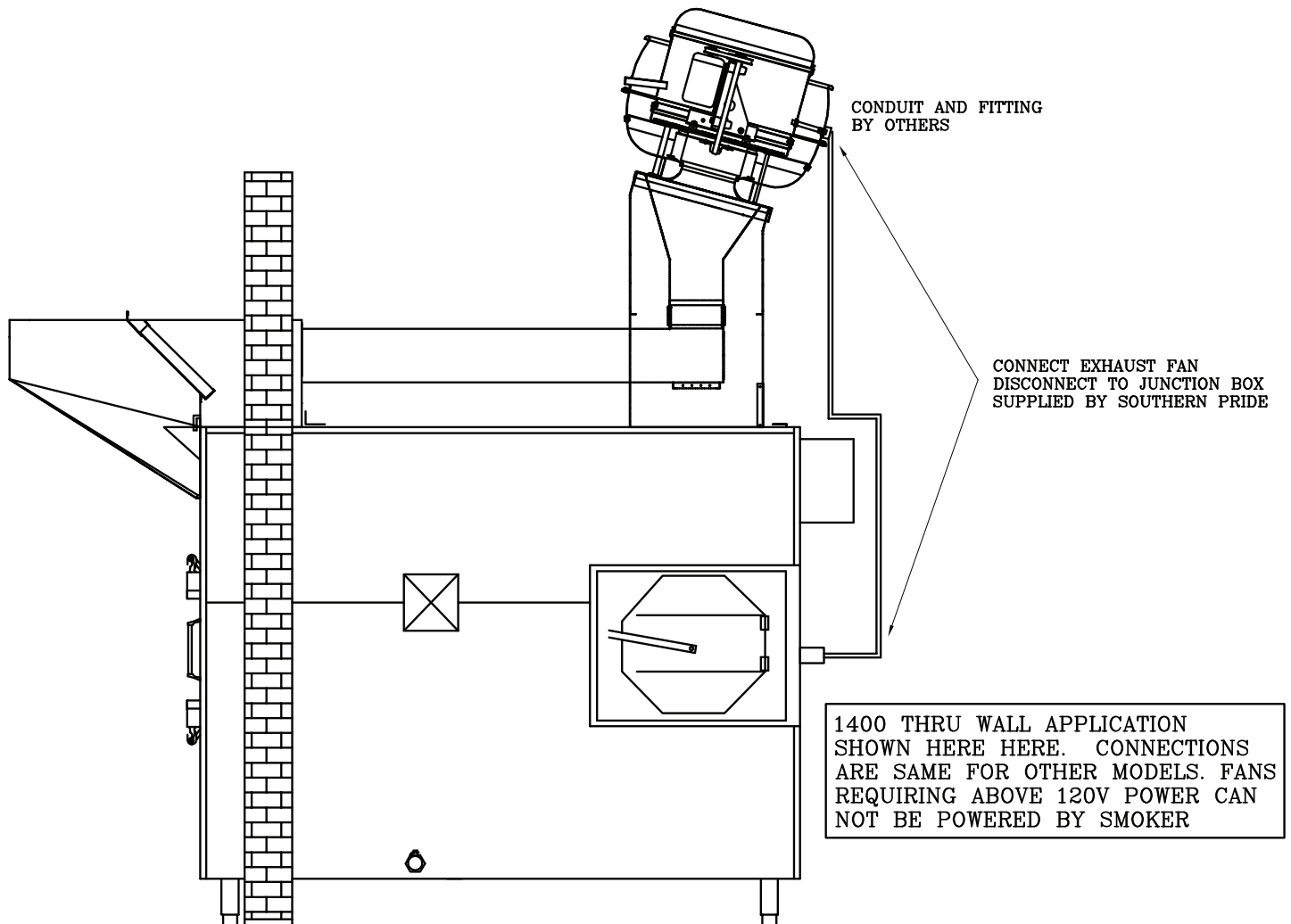
Wiring for 120V/60C/1P 2-Speed Fan Application

Warranty

Items Not Covered Under Warranty

Warranty

Storage Charges

Unified Brands makes every effort to consistently meet our customers' shipment expectations. If after the equipment has been fabricated, the customer requests delay in shipment, and warehousing is required:

- Equipment held for shipment at purchaser's request for a period 30 days beyond original delivery date specified will be invoiced and become immediately payable.
- Equipment held beyond 30 days after the original delivery date specified will also include storage charges.

Shipping & Delivery

Unified Brands will attempt to comply to any shipping, routing or carrier request designated by dealer, but reserves the right to ship merchandise via any responsible carrier at the time equipment is ready for shipment. A notation must be placed on the freight bill and signed for by the truck driver. Appearance of damage will require removing the crate in the presence of the driver. Consignee is responsible for filing of freight claims when a clear delivery receipt is signed. Claims for damages must be filed immediately (within 10 days) by the consignee with the freight carrier. Retain all cartons and merchandise for inspection.

Returned Goods

Authorization for return must first be obtained from Unified Brands before returning any merchandise. Ventilation Maintenance Guide

Roof Top Systems- Make Up Air & Exhaust Fans

1. Air intake filters should be cleaned monthly or more often as conditions dictate.
2. Check all belts for slippage and tighten as necessary.
3. Clean exhaust fan interior and wheel as required to prevent accumulation of grease that could lead to a fire hazard.
4. Electrical connections should be inspected every six months.
5. Oil and/or grease all motors and bearings every six months.
6. If supplied, check and empty grease collection cup on outside of exhaust fan.

Cleaning and Maintenance of Stainless Steel Hoods

1. Carefully wipe away gritty substances clinging to hood surface to avoid scratching.
2. Dilute ½ cup EVAC detergent with 1 gallon warm water.
3. Soak a cloth in the water detergent solution, wring out excess.
4. Rub the cloth in the direction of the grain.
5. Wipe stainless steel dry with a clean cloth.
6. Reapply stainless steel polish.
7. Empty and clean grease drain and cups as needed per your application.
8. Filters should be cleaned in a dishwasher or soak sink as needed per your application.

CAUTIONS **DO NOT** use steel wool (Brillo Pads), scrapers, or spatulas to clean hood!

DO NOT use the following substances on or around the hood!

1. Chlorine or chlorine based substances.
2. Acids (e.g. mercuric chloride, ferric chloride).

Vapors of the above substances can corrode stainless steel!
